A passionate gardener and rosarian for 30 years, I own and operate Rosman Gardens, a private 2 acre botanical garden-in-the-woods located in cold-zone 4b, in the mountains of upstate New York. Rosman Gardens houses an extensive collection of culinary, medicinal and ornamental herbs, native plants, ornamental grasses, rare wildflowers including hardy terrestrial orchids, bog plants, English garden perennials, and 250 roses, including many ancient and historic varieties, and 30 varieties (approximately 100) of David Austin English Shrub Roses, which I test and monitor for cold-hardiness and disease resistance for David Austin Roses Ltd., UK. Rosman Gardens have been featured in Womans Day - Gardening & Deck Design, and American Rose Magazine.

I am a garden designer and consultant throughout the Northeast. I conduct group garden tours and horticultural education programs at Rosman Gardens and in Northeastern public gardens such as the Berkshire Botanical Gardens in Stockbridge, Ma. and Landis Arboretum in Esperance, NY, and lecture throughout the Northeast on rose culture, garden design, and related topics. As a freelance garden writer and photographer, my articles have been nationally published in several magazines. My articles also appear on line with "Learn-to-Grow.com," and in public garden publications, such as the Berkshire Botanical Gardens magazine, "Cuttings".
